DIRECTIONS

ARRIVAL BY CAR

From the direction of Karlsruhe: Take the A8 motorway to the Stuttgart motorway interchange, “Vaihingen” exit. There, take the A831 motorway, then the B14 towards “Stuttgart-Zentrum” and continue on the B10/B14. Follow the signs for “NeckarPark”.

From the direction of Ulm: Take the A8 motorway to the “Esslingen-Zentrum” exit. There, take the B313, then the B10 towards Stuttgart. Follow the signs for “NeckarPark”.

From the direction of Heilbronn: Take the A81 motorway to the “Zuffenhausen” exit, then take the B10 towards “Stuttgart-Zentrum” and follow the signs for “NeckarPark” towards “Stuttgart-Bad Cannstatt/Esslingen”.

CLASSIC VEHICLES

We look forward to welcoming all visitors arriving by classic car (vehicles of all makes). You are welcome to park on the hill in front of the Museum if there are no events taking place. If you would like to know whether the hill is free on your preferred date, please enquire in advance whether it is possible to drive onto the hill. PARKING

Parking is available in the Museum’s multistorey car park (headroom 2.00 m) and in multistorey car park P4 (headroom 1.90 m). The parking fee for the first to third hour is EUR 2.00/hour, and from the fourth hour EUR 2.50/hour. If you make a purchase in our Museum Shop or dine in the restaurant, we give you free parking for the first hour upon presentation of your car park ticket.

ELECTRIC CHARGING STATIONS

There are 16 “Type 2” EV charging stations in the Museum’s multistorey car park. You can obtain a suitable charging cable from the information desk in the Atrium (E1) for a deposit. Either the provider’s charging card or the ChargePoint app is required for charging your electric vehicle. There are also nine lockers with electric charging stations for e-bike batteries.

EVENTS

Access to the Mercedes-Benz Museum is limited during VfB Stuttgart home football matches and major events. In these cases, we recommend using public transport.

ARRIVAL BY TRAIN

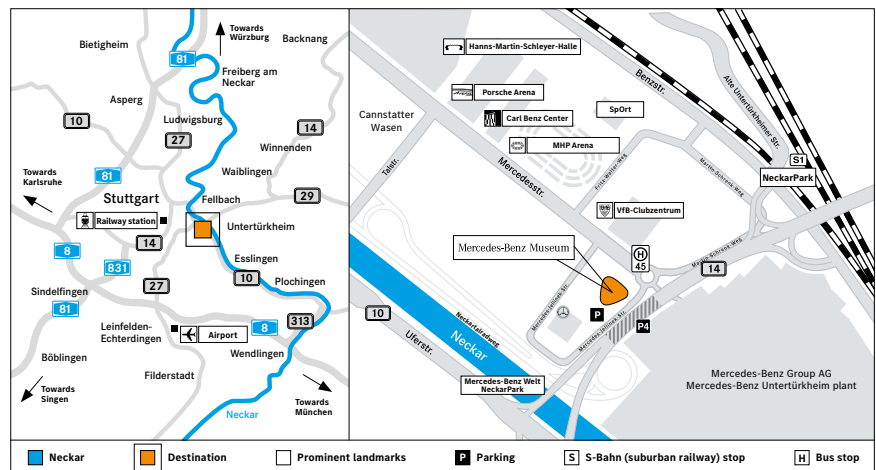
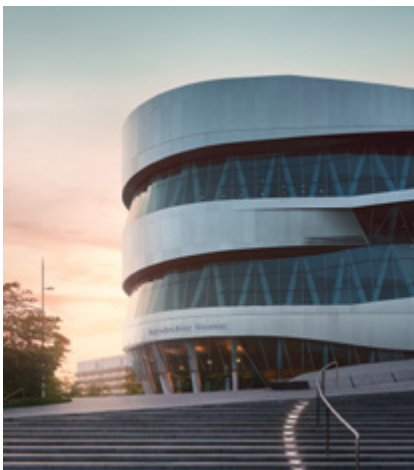

ARRIVAL BY BUS

From Bad Cannstatt railway station, take bus line 45 to the “Mercedes-Benz Welt” stop. Bad Cannstatt railway station can be reached by taking “S-Bahn” (suburban railway) lines S1, S2 or S3, as well as the regional train network or Regionalexpress.

ARRIVAL BY BIKE

BARRIER-FREE MUSEUM

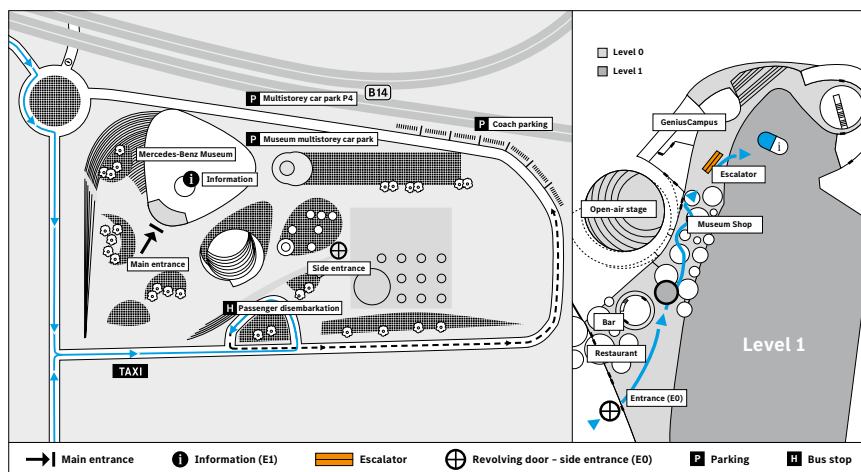
